

Supervisor James Schmitt opened the regular meeting of the town board of the Town of Pawling at 6:00 PM September 1, 2021 at the Pawling Town Hall, 160 Charles Colman Blvd., Pawling, New York. Present were Councilmen DeRosa, Johnson, Councilwoman Snow, town attorney Nancy Tagliafierro, and approximately 4 interested citizens. Councilmen McCarthy was absent.

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS

Supervisor Schmitt opened the meeting for public comment on agenda items and there were none.

RESOLUTIONS

The Board reviewed the resolutions and agreed they would be acted upon at next week's meeting.

TOWN BOARD DISCUSSION

Councilman Johnson said he would have more information on PWD #2 next week and he would report to the board at that time.

Councilwoman Snow said she would like to follow up with the ethics code next week. She suggested having department heads come and update the board from time to time.

Councilman DeRosa said Dutchess County Planning Federation put out their schedule for their three fall courses. One course is on 9/28 regarding the recreational marijuana law, the second is 10/26 regarding housing and on 11/10, the course will be regarding county referrals. These will all be webinars. Councilman DeRosa said he has been checking the lake. Since July 1st, we have had a foot of rain. It is a good test for the spillway, which is acting exactly as it is supposed to.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Wendel Weber, supervisor of buildings and grounds said he has been looking at defibrillators for all town buildings. He can get them now on state bid for \$10,808.00 for eight buildings. The bookkeeper said there is money for this so he would like to order them. There will need to be training, which is included with the purchase price.

Supervisor Schmitt made a motion to approve the purchase of eight defibrillators off the state bid contract, seconded by Councilman Johnson, motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Weber said the fuel oil bid is complete and he would bring that to the board next week for award of the bid. The new Lakeside Park entryway looks great and is almost finished. The Lions building roof and improvements are moving along.

The motion to adjourn was made by Supervisor Schmitt at 6:11 PM, seconded by Councilman Johnson, motion passed unanimously.
