The Town Supervisor or designee may:

- a. Interrupt, warn, or terminate an individual's comment when the comment is personally directed, abusive or obscene.
- b. Request that any individual leave the meeting when that individual fails to observe reasonable decorum.
- c. Call for a recess or an adjournment to another time.

### **The intent of these rules are:**

1. To allow members of the public a fair and adequate opportunity to be heard.
2. To assure that the regular agenda of the Town Board is completed; and
3. To recognize the nature of the Board and community's time and to use that time effectively.

## **RESOLUTION 2025-138**

## **Authorization of Inter-Fund Loan**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Pawling from time to time authorizes loans from funds to fund the initial cost of a project prior to grant funding being received, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Pawling does hereby authorize the following inter-fund loan:

1. \$100,000 from Hoffman Fund to support the Lakeside Entrance project.
2. Said funds shall be reimbursed to the Hoffman Fund, with interest at the current applicable rate, upon receipt of the corresponding grant funds.

## **Appointment of Full Time Mechanical Equipment Operator**

WHEREAS, a permanent full time Mechanical Equipment Operator (MEO) vacancy exists in the Highway Department, and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Highways has recommended that Justin Hyatt be appointed to fill said vacancy, and

## **Adopting 2026 Budget**

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Final Budget, as incorporated herein and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted as the annual budget of the Town of Pawling for the fiscal year beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2026 and that such budget as so adopted be entered in the minutes of the Town Board, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk of the Town of Pawling, Catherine Giordano, shall prepare and certify in duplicate, copies of said annual budget as adopted by this Town Board, and deliver one copy thereof to the Town Supervisor James Schmitt.
