Dear Cathy,

Paramount Pictures is currently in pre-production on a film tentatively titled, "Little Falls". The details below outline our preliminary requests associated with our intent to film at 35 Dodge Road, Pawling, NY 12564

Please note our tentative schedule below for work at 35 Dodge Road: (subject to change)

**Prep: approx. 3 days of rehearsal at some point between the last week of June and July 10.
July 20, (potentially July 16th and July 17)**
Remediation: approx. 5 days starting June 11
Shoot: Tuesday, July 21, Wednesday, July 22 & Thursday, July 23
Wrap: Friday, July 24

Please see below our current requests for work surrounding 35 Dodge Road:

- Permission to allow all brush in the area outlined in Exhibit B to overgrow. This would include the postponing of brush hogging on Dover Road within the map by local DPW
- **Permission to run camera car and motorcycles along Holiday Hills Lane (See Exhibit A)**
- **Permission to add swing set/ add window treatments to the house**
- **Ability to park SPFX Trailer on site during rehearsal days**
- **Permission to park crew cars near set on prep days**
- Permission to perform TBD Traffic Lock Up per Dutchess County Sheriffs Department on Dodge Road (See Exhibit C)
- Permission to ride motor bikes and ATV's in area designated in Exhibit A (Our stunt department would like the opportunity to test their run with motor bikes at the following dates (April 28, 29, 30) under the supervision of Wendel Weber and safety measures taken on by our team. (Wendel Weber does not need to be present throughout the duration only when he sees fit)
- Permission to clear brush ~~and/or small trees~~ (if necessary) in order to secure a safe riding path in area designated in Exhibit A. Revegetation can take place upon completion of filming if necessary. Work to be done by Luna Brothers upon receipt of COI and Hold Harmless
- Permission to rig cable for cable cameras to select trees inside Exhibit B
- Permission to use all natural tick/ mosquito and snake remediation methods inside Exhibit B
- Permission to run cable on portions of town property. Cable will be safely and neatly secured.
- Permission to use a non-firing prop weapons with permission from local police.
- Permission to fly camera drones with licensed drone operator.
- Permission to access surrounding fire hydrants (with permission from the DPW).
- Permission to stage standard camera, lighting and prop equipment on town property.
- Permission to disconnect tractors from production trailers once parked.
- Permission to leave lift gates on working trucks down.
- Permission to park and operate non vending food trucks in our footprint.
- Permission to operate a DOT permitted van generator.
- ~~Permission to use the Rec Center as Crew Holding/ Catering~~
- Permission to land trucks and tractor trailers on Dodge Road while traffic is being detoured (See Exhibit C)
- Permission to use the Pawling Rink Parking Lot to rig motorcycles

- Permission to postpone brush hog operations on West Dover Road until completion of filming in space indicated in Exhibit D (w/ additional permission from the Town of Dover)
- Permission to "Sweet Peet" the roads (as was done in summer of 2019) in the space indicated in Exhibit D (w/ additional permission from the Town of Dover)
- Permission to detour traffic on West Dover Road between the 2 points indicate in Exhibit D (w/ additional permission from the Town of Dover)
- Permission to fly and land a Helicopter in a field located at 624 West Dover Road.
- Permission to operate 125' Articulating condors and BeeBee lights on premise.
- Permission to use prop weapons with permission from local police (DOVER however sound may travel).

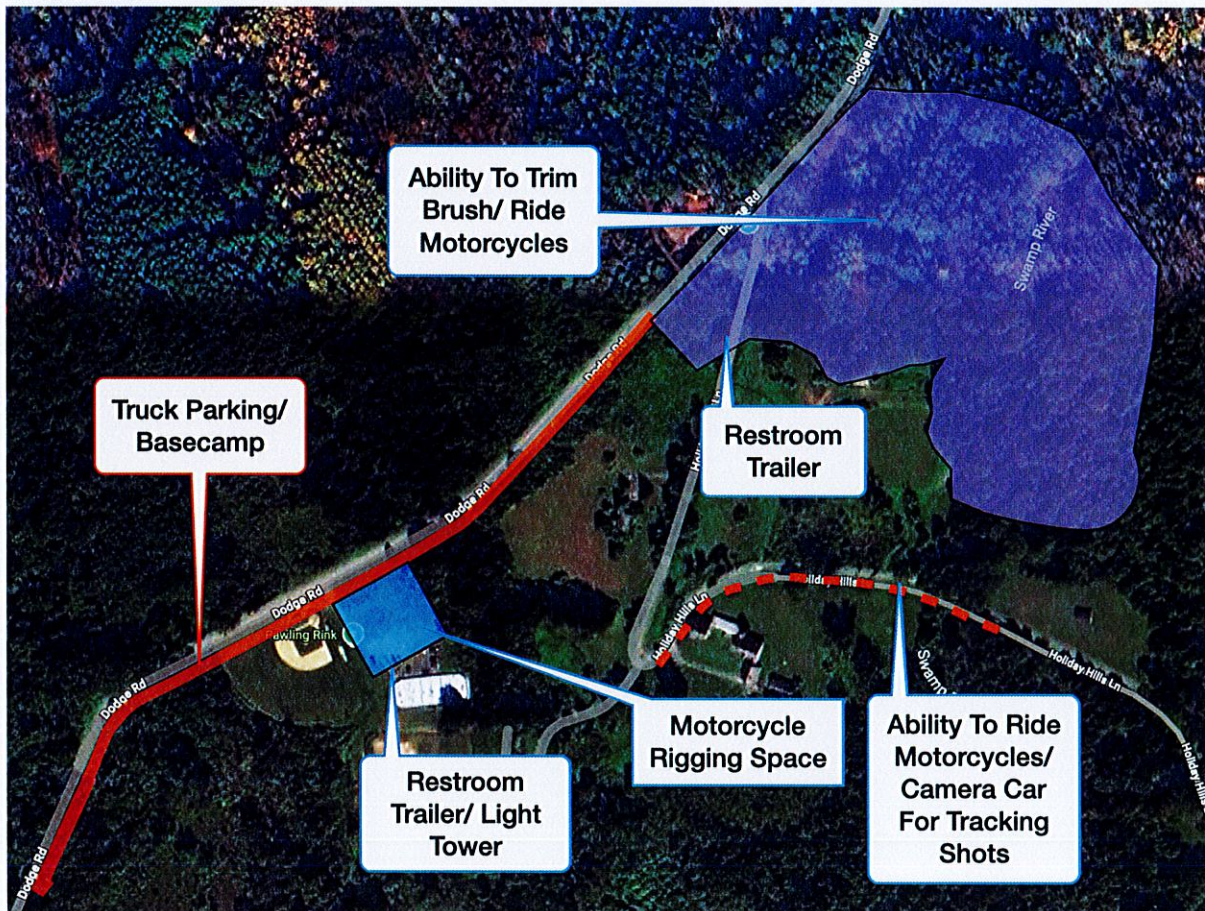

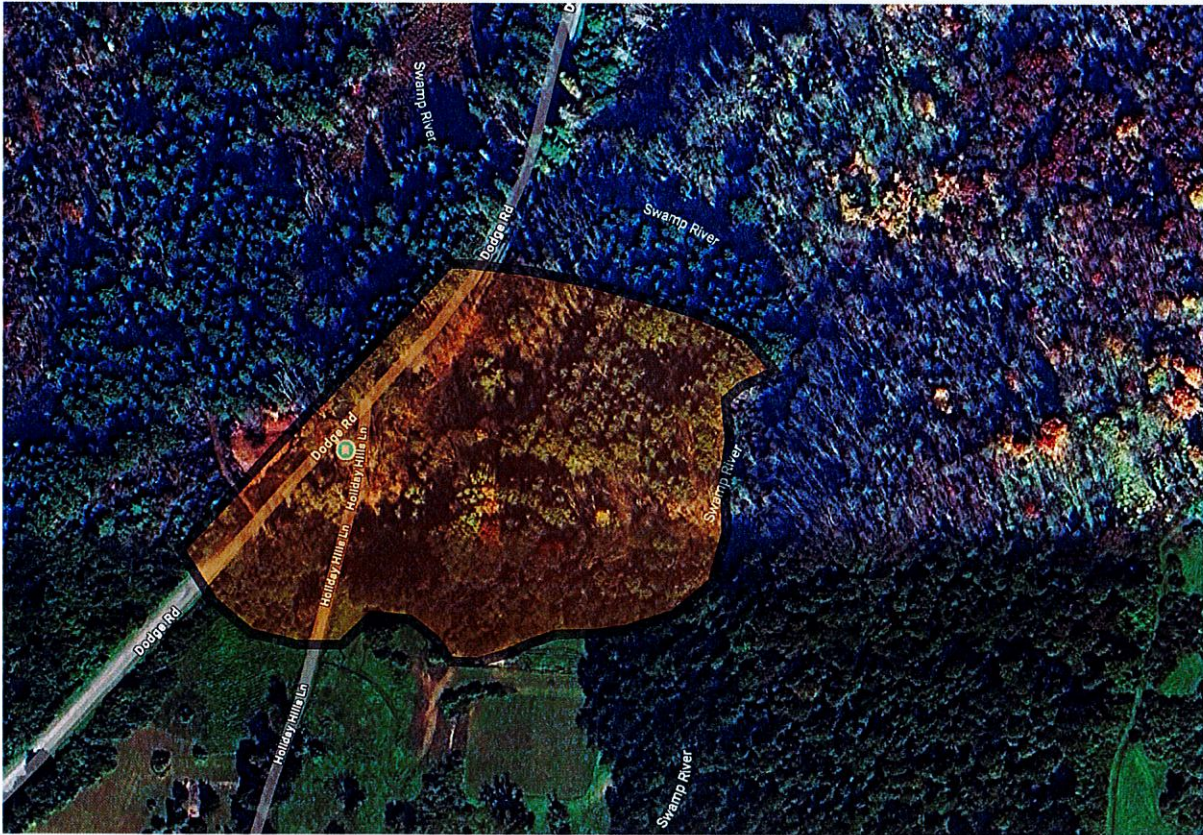

LAKESIDE PARK OVERHEAD



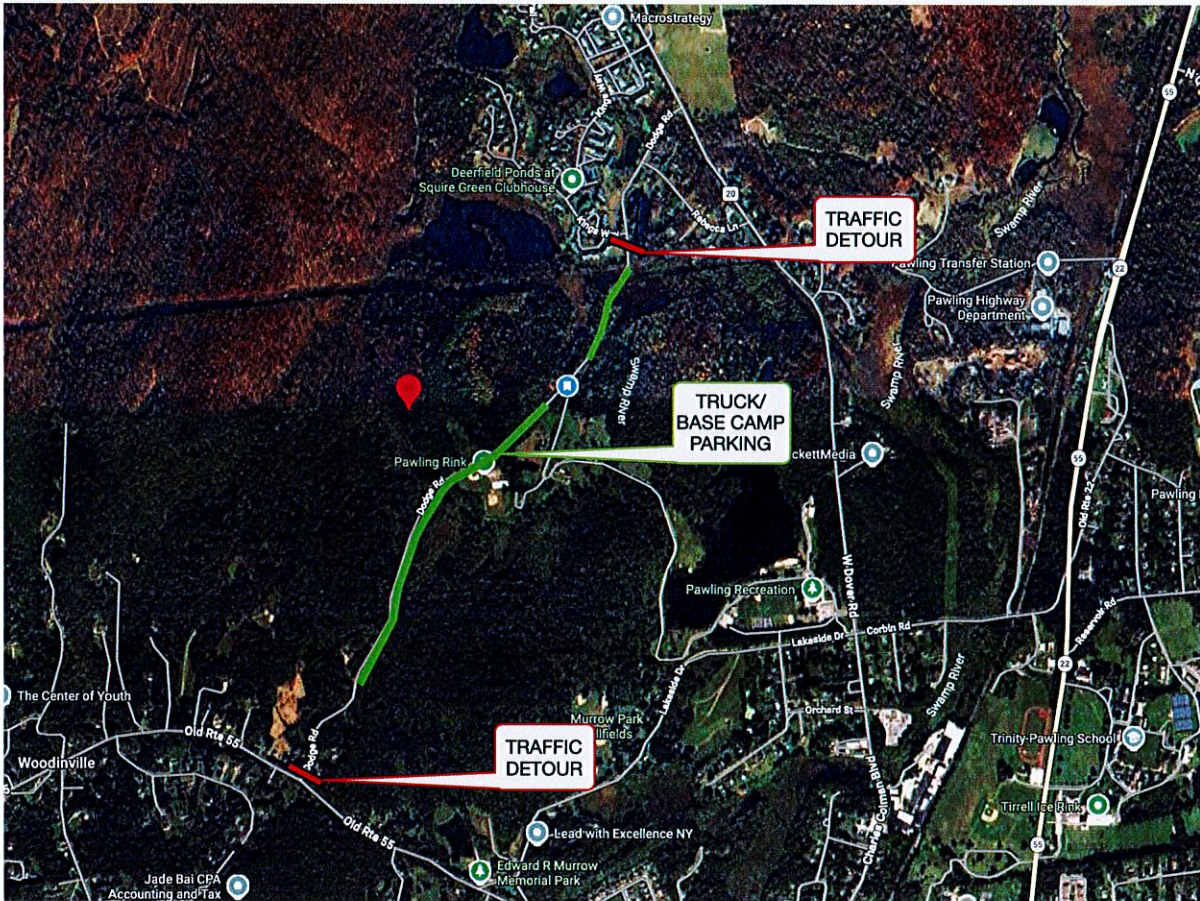
